## A note from Novahu....

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ!

I thank the Immanuel church that you make the difference in the lives of the people. Since from its inception our target and aim is “seek and save the lost”. Recently I met grandfather of Vamsi Krishna Prasad, who is our former graduate from 10<sup>th</sup> standard. It gave me more hope and our effort is not in vain.

The story goes this way. Vamsi Krishna Prasad belong to Madhavapatnam. He was admitted to Marshall High School in the beginning of the ministry. Perhaps admitted into 3<sup>rd</sup> standard. He was in the school. He was orphan, his mother was passed away due to cancer. His father run in debts. His father attempted to sell his house at some point of time, but he could not. While Vamsi Krishna Prasad is studying we saw a great talent in him that is a “dancer”. We encouraged him and gave every opportunity to improve his talent. Due to recognition problem with our school at that time his father removed him at 7<sup>th</sup> Standard and admitted him 3 miles away in one of the government high school. He lost his interest in studies, and no opportunities for cultivate his dancing skills. He lost knowledge in English also. He failed 10th Standard. He thought his life is gone. He father did a great mistake that he removed him from Marshall High School. His father also admitted this fact many times with me. And asked me to guide him and make his life more meaning full. One fine day as I was going to the school I saw him on the road. I asked him what he was doing. He said, that he failed 10<sup>th</sup> standard. His life and his ambition is lost. No hope in his life. I said to him, do not worry, I will try helping you, will you come and rejoin

Only because of us JJM and Marshall High School he is, what he is now. Later he completed his ITI industrial Training got certificate and now he is doing private job. Now, they slowly clearing the debts. Not selling his property and living happily. Because of your encouragement and guidance, I'm having this good life. His grandfather is very much thankful for JJM and Marshall high School. He is a living witness for the "seek and save the lost".

Please continue to pray for this type of children.

I remember a story in Marks gospel chapter 5. Jesus allowed 2000 pigs to die for one single soul. A person is more important than the money for property. I thank Immanuel church that you do a great job. All the credit goes to Immanuel Church West Bend. You change the lives of our people.
