The Tables Have Turned!

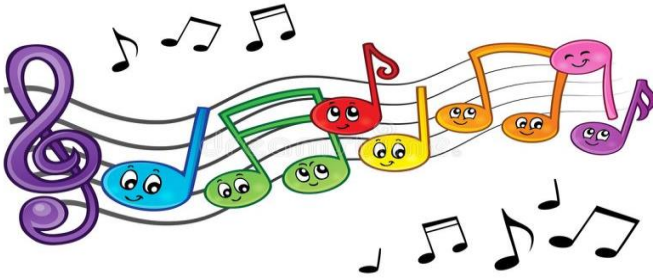

If that's you, read on!!

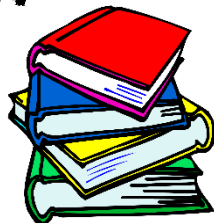

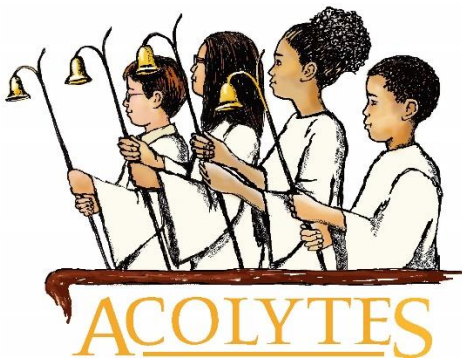

ATTENTION ALL KIDS 3RD GRADE AND OLDER!!

All children third grade or older are invited to become a member of the **Acolyte Guild**. Throughout the year, these children provide worship leadership by lighting and extinguishing candles at the **9:00 a.m. worship service**, as well as candle lighting during Advent, on Christmas Eve, and on Maundy Thursday.

If you'd like to join the Acolyte Guild, or just want to see what it's all about, simply come to **one** of two upcoming **training sessions**. At the end of the session, if you decide to join, you will be put on the acolyte schedule beginning in October 2018.

Training sessions will be held on **September 16th and 23rd**, right after JAM Time and church, from **11:30 a.m. until 12:15 p.m.** in the sanctuary. At the session, children will learn the procedures to follow when serving as an acolyte. Veteran acolytes need only stay for a verbal review of the instructions, which will take approximately 15 to 20 minutes.

All children (including veteran guild members) who wish to acolyte must attend one of the training sessions.

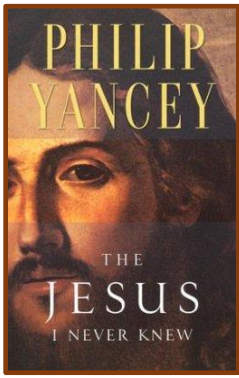

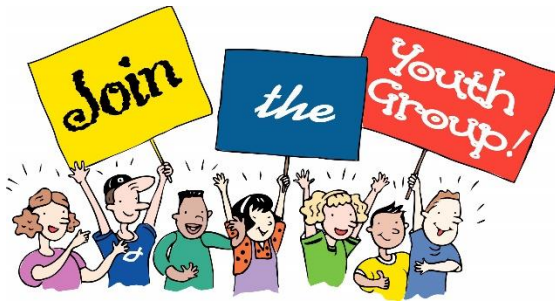

Novahu personally trains and prepares leaders to go into their villages and preach the Gospel to those seeking to grow in their understanding and commitment to Christ. Many of these men and women are compensated with a mere bag of rice or a couple of eggs from their congregation as that is all they can afford to give them. Through our sponsorship program, a **House Pastor can be supported for \$35 a month**; this allows them to continue spreading the word of Jesus without worrying about financially supporting their own families based on what their congregation can give them.

India Bake Sale



Hello Friends!

It is that time of year again to start thinking about the India Rummage Bake Sale! The last three years have been a HUGE success which have been a blessing to our India Ministry. This year, I'd like to make the sale even BIGGER and BETTER!!!! In order to do that, I need YOU, the wonderful members of Immanuel Church to help me by donating your talents through making baked goods for us to sell or donating the gift of your time by helping the prep crew package/price baked goods on Thursday 8/23 or to help us run the booth during rummage sale hours on Friday 8/24 thru Saturday 8/25!!!

We will be accepting all different types of baked goods. If you donate, a few important things to note:

1). If donating whole pies, cakes, quick breads, sandwich breads, etc. -- PLEASE make sure they come to us in disposable packaging (disposable pie tins, loaf pans, etc.). We don't want anyone to lose their favorite glass or metal pans!

2). If you wish to donate items like cookies, brownies, bars, etc., you DO NOT need to worry about cutting, portioning, packaging or pricing them. Feel free to bring them in regular trays, plates, etc., that you can pick back up from church. Our prep crew will take care of the cutting, packaging and pricing as we will have materials available for that on site. It will also allow us to sell a uniform product.

3). To give you an idea of things that sold well last year -- whole items like homemade pies, cakes, quick breads, sandwich breads, etc. Since these went over so well, an increase in the donation of these kinds of items would be appreciated! Other items that sold well -- portable, kid-friendly items! Homemade granola or snack bars, trail/snack mixes (both sweet and savory), puppy chow, different varieties of rice krispy treats, cookie pops, etc. All of these were a hit with the kids that came through! All kinds of bars, cookies, muffins, cupcakes, etc. also sold well last year!

4.) Lastly, if your donated items are gluten-free or contain any allergens (peanuts/tree nuts, peanut butter, soy, dairy, eggs, etc.), Please make sure to note that with a label or on paper such that the prep crew can label the items appropriately. We don't want people to accidentally have reactions from any allergens in donated items that weren't appropriately labeled!

We will have sign-up sheets available for donations as well as for prep crew and booth help. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me! As always, thank you in advance for helping to make this bake sale a wonderful success!!
