The first phase of our Basement Restoration Project is complete and Immanuel's Youthful "Shine Brites" will once again be able to return to their classrooms for J.A.M. Time, Confirmation and Youth Group!!

We are grateful for the many hands that have brought us to this point... from the first drop of water that seeped in and beyond, our church family has worked hard in a variety of ways to save our lower level and for this we *GIVE THANKS!*

The approximate cost for this portion of restoring our classrooms has come to roughly \$17,000. This includes, clean-up, mold purification, paint & dry wall repair, and our new epoxy flooring.

The next phase of our Basement Restoration Project that is scheduled to begin after the New Year would be the hallways, choir room, and Fellowship Hall.

Please continue to pray for this project and for all those who are so generously giving of their time to help keep the costs down.

During December, Immanuel Church will receive a special offering for **The Christmas Fund for the Veterans of the Cross and the Emergency Fund**, one of four yearly Special Mission offerings of the UCC. For over a century, The Christmas Fund has been a tangible expression of God's love and light in the world. Year after year, UCC members and congregations have reached out in kindness, compassion, and gratitude to those who have faithfully shepherded our Church in the past and who now find themselves facing unexpected financial needs.

In 2017, gifts to the Christmas Fund enabled

- Small pension supplementation for 424 retired clergy, lay employees, and surviving spouses/partners, totaling \$1,513,602
- Health benefits supplementation for 210 retired clergy, lay employees, and surviving spouses/partners, totaling \$492,863
- Emergency grants for 384 servants of the church, totaling \$136,012
- Christmas "Thank You" gift checks to 477 retired clergy, lay employees, and their surviving spouses, totaling \$228,300
