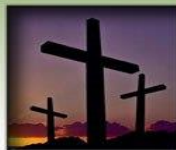

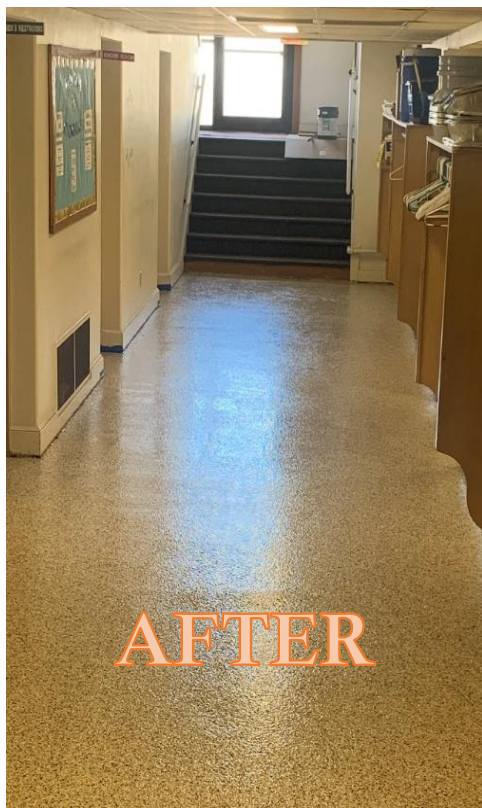
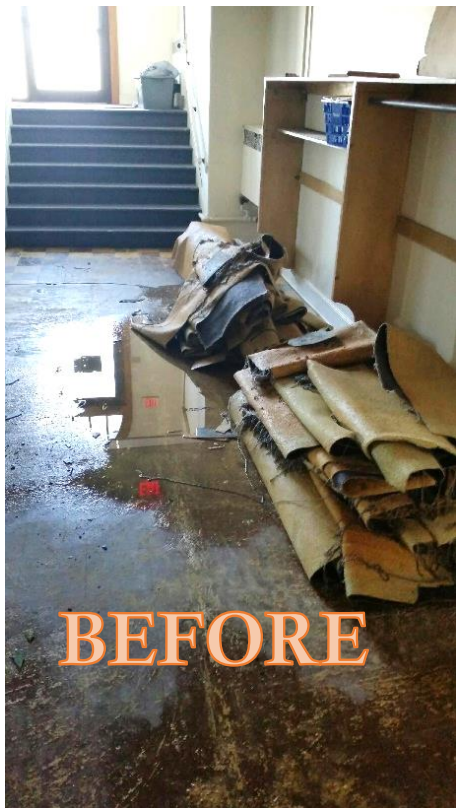

Finance Committee Report Basement Restoration

The church basement is ALMOST FINISHED! Dave Hammen has done an amazing job managing this project. And thanks to all the prayers, volunteer hours, donated equipment, and financial support, we have arrived on the other side of this crisis standing tall. The basement flooring is beautiful, and waterproof. And just as the final flooring work was done, requiring the final payment, a member surprised the church with a donation of just over \$11,000, which resulted in almost wiping out the Flood Relief Fund's deficit. We give thanks for ALL the contributions toward this effort, from \$2 to \$11,000. Every single dollar that was donated added up to ENOUGH! We also must again thank everyone who donated their time and talents toward this project. The time given by members since August when this all started adds up to a significant financial savings. Conservative estimates of over 500 hours translates to tens of thousands of dollars! Pastor Rich reminded all of us to "not panic" and he correctly predicted that we would get through this.

Childcare Available

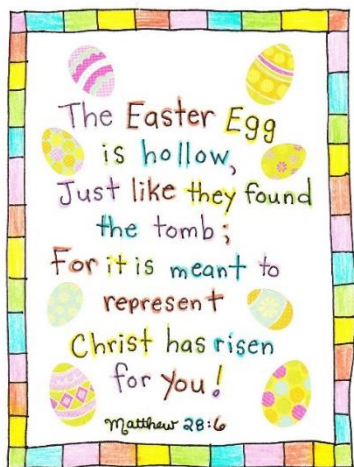

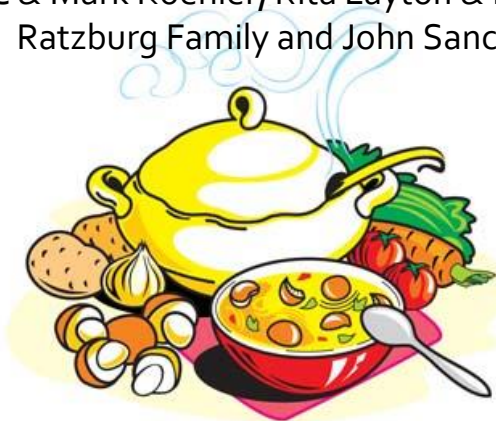
“Soup and Solitude” for Lent
