

Kicking us off, Week 1...



As COVID-19 continues to wreak havoc on the world, we recognize that currently India is being hit especially hard. Just as when the pandemic first began, lockdowns in villages, can mean basic necessities, like food, are harder to acquire. Simple hygiene products and items that would help prevent the spread of the virus including masks, soap, and hand sanitizer can be almost impossible to come by for underprivileged individuals. Through the generous donations in support of the Joyful Journeys India~COVID-19 Relief Fund (JJI~CRF), and with the help of village officials, we have been able to purchase these items and distribute them within Madhavapatnam and beyond, and will continue to do so as long as our resources allow. Now in addition to those needs, as vaccines are becoming available in this area, we hope to provide monetary assistance to ensure that those in the village who want to be vaccinated, but may not have the funds to do so, will be able to get the shot, if desired.
