Update on 4 Way Covenant with Rev. Jim Schleif...

What does it mean to be part of a 4 Way Covenant with a pastor? Well, among other things this is what our commitment with Rev. Jim Schleif entails...

- 1) Immanuel agrees to consider Rev. Schleif as a resource for ministry within the congregation which may be beneficial and agreeable to all parties.

 Certainly, we would like to use Jim as a resource as much as possible, however it is important that we recognize that his primary focus is to his job with UCCI, and therefore it is vital that we respect healthy boundaries so that we don't overload his plate. This is something that is prayerfully considered on both sides whenever an opportunity presents itself for Jim to serve here at Immanuel.
- 2) Immanuel UCC agrees to provide spiritual and community support for Rev. Schleif and his ministry. As you will see in Jim's article below, he has quite a bit going on in his life. Now is a time for us to "lean into our end of the Covenant" as his church family and provide the support he needs during this time of transition. Please keep Rev. Jim in your prayers as well as his wife Beverly. May they be blessed as the Holy Spirit works in and through them.

Dear Immanuel UCC family,

I am penning a brief note to update you as to where my specialized ministry within the United Church Camps, Inc. (UCCI) has taken me of late.

Last November, my role within UCCI moved to the Director of Ministry and Site Operations. In this position, I assumed responsibility for the operation of all three of our sites, at Moon Beach, Daycholah Center, and Cedar Valley. We realized that after two years of pandemic and the challenges faced under these conditions, that our sites needed more direct support from the UCCI leadership team. In this role, we have collectively been working to strengthen our site teams, reboot our retreat and camp ministry, and work diligently toward allowing 2022 to be a rebound year. I am actively utilizing organizational leadership skills developed in my previous vocational leadership roles. God seems to put us in places where our skill sets are demanded in a manner that we least expect.

Our Executive Director, Mr. Glenn Svetnicka, has decided that after 20 years of faithful service in outdoor ministry, that it is time to move on. Mr. Svetnicka will resign as Executive Director on April 29. I have been asked to fulfill the position of Interim Executive Director as we face the season ahead and determine the next steps for UCCI. This role will also demand organizational leadership and pastoral skills. I am sure the year ahead will provide challenges, but I am excited about the future of outdoor ministry and living into the post-pandemic era. This is truly a deflection point for all of us and amid the uncertainty, we can trust that God walks this journey with us. Lead on, O Holy One! Respectfully submitted,

On behalf of our President...

Spring is here and with it comes many wonderful things, Easter, warmer weather, baseball, the Wacky-Tacky Talent Show, many lost golf balls (ok that's not that wonderful but getting back on the course sure is.) Spring also brings something else at Immanuel UCC: turnover on our Consistory. Pretty much every year at least one or two members of Consistory are ending either their first or second 3-year term. Those ending the first term can choose to serve another. Sometimes they do and sometimes they need to move on. Those wrapping their second term, by our church's Constitution, need to be off Consistory for at least one full year.

Thus, every year we have the need for new Consistory members and a new opportunity for some in our church family to be able to serve in that capacity. You may be asking "what is Consistory?" It is an unusual word. When our family first came to Immanuel, I had never heard it either. Basically, it is our church council, our lay leadership group, comprised of 4 Elders (eligible to be chosen as such after one year of Consistory membership), 6 Deacons, the Pastor, the Director of Ministries, and the Treasurer. Within the Consistory we have 4 officers: President (currently me,) Vice-President (Jan Nesladek right now,) Secretary (thank you Becky Kay!) and Treasurer (the incomparable and tireless Dave Hammen.)

What does Consistory do, you ask? We meet once per month, at least 9 months out of year, to discuss the business of running the church across topics including issues that come up with the property or with ministry opportunities, membership, requests to use the building by both members and non-members, or anything else that might need to be dealt with. The largest responsibility we have is to review and approve the annual church budget every fall, after it has been drafted and reviewed by the Finance Committee.

Additionally, Pastor Rich, Jenny, and the Elders comprise the Church and Ministry group, meeting for an hour or so prior to the monthly Consistory meeting to discuss more sensitive matters within Immanuel or matters that might be then brought before the larger Consistory, usually related to ministry or worship-related topics that need to be discussed and decided on. All decisions are put to a vote following the procedures in Roberts Rules of Order. Sometimes voting is handled via email in similar fashion as well. The time commitment is generally a couple of hours on a Thursday night once per month and responding to occasional emails as needed.

Serving on Consistory is an important and valuable way to contribute to our church family here at Immanuel. Hopefully I've been able to de-mystify some of what it means to participate in our lay leadership, and the time and level of effort that's involved. I ask that as you look for ways to serve our wonderful community at Immanuel, that you prayerfully consider Consistory if you should ever be approached in the future with a request to join the group.

Property Update...

This past month we had to replace a water heater in the church basement. It was still under warranty, so it was replaced at minimal cost.

The COF toilet was replaced.

The light timer that controls the light in stained glass window in the sanctuary and the outside sign board failed. New timer was ordered and replaced.

One of the ventilation turbine fans on the church roof blew off during one of our wind events in early March. C & K services were contacted and they will be replacing it as soon as the parts are available.

We are actively obtaining estimates from roofing companies for the replacement of the Circle of Friends house roof and gutters. We have one estimate and we have two more estimates pending.

These estimates will be presented to the congregation at our Annual Congregational Meeting on April 3rd.

We are also obtaining an estimate from Kettle Moraine Heating to restore heat to the radiator on the north wall in the Narthex.

Last call on the stove and refrigerator removed from the Circle of Friends house. Contact Dave at property@immanuelwestbend.org if you are interested in either one. If no one is interested, they will be donated to Habitat for Humanity.

Once again, I want to thank our property guys, Jim Peters, Glenn Radzinski, Mark Koehler for taking care of these things for minimal cost for our church.


BUY A BOARD - BUILD A BENCH

A little note that on April 10 we will not be meeting since I will be taking part in a graduation ceremony for UW-Milwaukee.


I am also tentatively planning on not meeting on Easter Sunday so that you all may spend the day having brunch and whatnot with your families.
