Two vehicles that were vital in the daily operations recently had to be scrapped and it is critical that we replace them with something that will allow our ministry to function efficiently.

The cost of a new van that would be customized to fit our needs is \$22,000.

Currently we have raised \$8,060... that means \$13,940 to go!!



VBS in Madhavapatnam

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ!

I thank you very much for all your support to our Marshall School students and Joyful Journey Ministries. I am especially thankful for your support with Vacation Bible School; I also thank Oma for her support in distribution of soaps. Many parents expressed that the children need moral teachings moral education and requested us to conduct VBS after not having it for two years because of COVID. Within a short period of time, you accepted our request and grant the VBS money. We are so much thankful to you. Through this we teach love of Jesus and sow the seed of the word of God.

Because of our VBS, all our Marshall School children are different from other Madhavapatnam children. Our school is meant for "SEEK AND SAVE THE LOST"; due to COVID, at this time, there are many lost in our village. These are some of the challenges we are facing...

Children become more rebellious:

During the last two years, there is a lot of change of behavior in the children, they become arrogant, rebellious, not interested in studies, addicted to watching movies and playing video games. If parents are not getting internet connection to the children, they are becoming unruly.

Immoral behavior of the children:

Now, with more children having technological devices, they have more access to inappropriate videos and immoral behavior. Their actions and language are not proper so to them we present message of Jesus to correct their language and stop watching bad movies.

Theft.

Due to the extreme poverty in our community, stealing things is a common behavior of the children. They steal notebooks, pens, erasers, and food from other children. Our VBS teacher teaches of honesty and virtue in the classes.

Teaching girls to maintain distance from boys and maintain hygiene.

Our girl children are growing and reaching puberty, teaching proper hygiene is critical for their well-being. Also, by 10th grade some of the girls marrying or eloping because of dowry costs. With the women counselor, we teach them how to maintain distance from the boys and why to maintain distance. Encouraging the importance of completing their education and teaching on setting up life goals is also part of VBS.

All our teachers, some relatives, and most of our church members helped in the VBS. They are very happy. More than 400 children came to participate in our VBS. Most of the children are students from Marshall School, but some are just from the village. We had very hot weather, 110 Fahrenheit degrees of heat, and still, most of the children present in the VBS, I thank God for that. Parents also cooperated to our VBS. We shared the love of Jesus to all the children. Please continue to pray for our children so they remember all they learned and practice it in their lives.


