Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

Summer break is winding down and a new school year is upon us. With this new year, many of our regular ministries like J.A.M. Time, Shine, and Confirmation are starting anew. Prior to the disruption to the "norm" that Covid brought in the last few years, we would annually celebrate this new beginning with "Rally Day" – a day to draw attention to the start of significant ministries and stir excitement for participation and support of these ministries.

Thoughts from Immanuel's Financial Secretary...

As I reflect upon the past several months in my new role as Immanuel's Financial Secretary and being around the church office, there are several things I have noted thus far: I am truly amazed at all the ways our congregation shares their time and talents within our church and our ministries; it's with the heart of Jesus that I see people caring for one another both within the church community and beyond; and certainly the generosity as treasures are shared is definitely an expression of devotion to our Creator. All these things, coupled with a new found purpose within myself and an appreciation for those I'm working with have put an assurance in my heart that I'm exactly where God is calling me to be at this point in my life. Thank you for giving me this opportunity to use my gifts to serve here at Immanuel.

Now that I'm becoming more acclimated to my new position and getting on top of things, there are a few items I'd like to highlight for you regarding Immanuel's finances. To keep it simple, I'll put it in bullet point form...

- Immanuel's ministries are coming back to "pre-COVID times"; how wonderful that we are "getting back to normal", but keep in mind, as activity increases within the church, so do our expenses.
- So far, 2022 has brought on extra property expenses that needed to be addressed, between putting a new roof on our Circle of Friends Shoppe, fixing our elevator, and replacing our boiler, we had \$87,000 in additional costs above our typical property maintenance. Thank you to everyone who gave extra thus far to help defray these further costs.
- Have you noticed your utility bills increasing in your home? Our church home is no different. Praise God we have heat in the winter and air-conditioning in the summer!
- Bottom line, as of July 31st, 2022 our YTD giving has met 77% of our expenses resulting in a deficit of \$52,349.36. Going back to my opening statements, we are truly a community of Spirit-filled followers of Christ who are shining the light of God's love to the world; I have seen us come together in time of need, together we can get back on top of our finances.

Property Update...

Here are the latest property updates. First off on the Narthex Heat and Boiler issue. As was stated in the last Journey Connection it has been decided after conversations, we had with our finance committee and then on to consistory that a decision has been made to replace the boiler instead of the heat exchanger.

The cost of the new heat exchanger was around \$9,200.00. The Boiler cost is \$18,832.66.

The heat exchanger would have a 1-year warranty where the new boiler once it is installed will have a 10-year warranty on all components as long as we maintain a documented maintenance schedule.

We will be scheduling the installation in the next few weeks. According to their Boiler Tech he will have four installers on site to complete the boiler replacement and restoring the heat to our radiator in the Narthex.

Our elevator had an issue, but Otis showed up and had to make a minor Hydraulic Valve Adjustment and replace a circuit board that should have been replaced but was not on the last repair, he took care of that at no cost to us.

We had an issue with the elevator phone but between Johanna and I after some trouble shooting, we were able to remedy the issue.

The last couple years, Novahu and Manjula incorporated a graduate's reunion within the celebration; this year we had almost 50 graduates of the Marshall School return for the program! The Celebration is not only filled with recognition and testimonies, but there is also dancing, a social time and sweet treats. Praise God from whom all Blessings flow!



Joyful Journeys Health Fair



Prior to COVID, Joyful Journeys Ministry in India would annually hold a Health Fair for the students at Marshall School, however, under the circumstances, that had to be forgone these past two years. If glasses or medications were needed, they were provided at little to no cost to the patients depending on their circumstances. This was all possible thanks to generous donations put into a special Joyful Journeys fund set up for assisting with medical issues, and the non-profit CMC organization.

What a blessing Novahu and Manjula are to Joyful Journeys as they are truly the hands and feet of this ministry, striving to serve the people in this remote village of India with the love of Christ!
