### A WORD, OR TWO FROM OUR PASTOR...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

The most obvious change in my life over the past few weeks has been the loss of any ability to plan for the future with confidence. As you all know, I'm not necessarily a "planner" by nature, but in the past I could afford to live like this because of the deep rhythms that shaped my life: Each week was mostly like the week before and allowed for consistent routines to provide stability and structure for my life.

But all this has changed. It's impossible at this point to know what the coming week will look like because my health is so unpredictable. For example: One day I'm going in for chemo, only to realize my body can't handle it and I need a platelet transfusion. Then the platelet transfusion wipes me out more than the chemo ever did. (Examples could be multiplied, but I don't want to bore you with the details.)

In the midst of this constant instability, I can go from feeling confident, strong, and hopeful to feeling absolutely overwhelmed, useless, and hopeless in the space of moments. At times, I feel like I'm letting everyone down. At other times, I rest in the care and prayers of those who love me. Throughout all of this, the Psalms in particularly have been my friend. The deep emotions expressed in the Psalms – the tragic sense of loss, the urgent need for hope, the constant call for trust – have brought me peace and consolation in the midst of chaos.

As always, I am grateful for your love and support, your kindness and your prayers, your cards and your encouraging words. All of these give me great joy and I hope to continue to receive these beautiful gifts. But right now, what I need the most from each and everyone of you is your faithful presence as a covenant community of Christ. Nothing would encourage me more than to know the church continues strong in faithful worship of God and loving service to one another and our community and beyond.

Put simply: If you're asking yourself how you can best love, support, and help me during this unstable, unpredictable time in my life, the answer is simple: Be a stable, faithful presence in the faith community of Immanuel UCC.

I often tell people who are struggling with faith that it is ok to struggle and that I will "have faith for them" until they are able to offer it themselves. So now I'm asking you: While I'm unable to be physically present or show up at all, will you be a "faithful presence" for me? While my life continues to be characterized by instability and structure, will you hold onto stability and structure for me?

And, of course, in the end, I'm not really asking for my own sake, but for the sake of Christ, for whom we do all things. Our call is to "faithful presence" to one another. In other words, our call is to "show up". This, quite simply, is what it means to be a church, a faith community, the body of Christ.

(Well, at least for 10 days or so.)

Though I'm no longer counting down weeks of school (ok, it's work now) it's still a strong reminder that time marches quickly in December and there's often a lot still to be done. Recently we passed a budget, as both myself and others have shared with all of you, we have work to do to get back to firm financial footing at Immanuel. We've been regathered for almost a year and a half now, and most of our pre-Covid ministries and activities are up and going as they'd been before the pandemic. With that, along with some heavy expenses for boiler and elevator repairs, the cost of Immanuel being Immanuel are back at equal or even higher than pre-Covid levels as well.

There's little doubt that as we celebrate God's most precious gift of Jesus, most of us, myself included, will be happy to turn the calendar to 2023. It's no secret that 2022 was a year of great challenge for our church family, and our current financial crunch continues to be one. But as we journey through Advent, a season of hope and expectation, let us also journey on in faith, that just as He has so many times before, God will see us through our present challenges.

This holiday season, may we all look to our Lord for faith, and guidance, trusting that he will fill each of our minds with His wisdom and clarity of purpose, each of our hearts with His love for both Him and each other, and our souls with His peace, knowing that all is in His mighty hands.


