Then, at **6:00pm we will gather in the Sanctuary** for an intimate (in-person only) devotional including, scripture, prayer, discussion, and song.

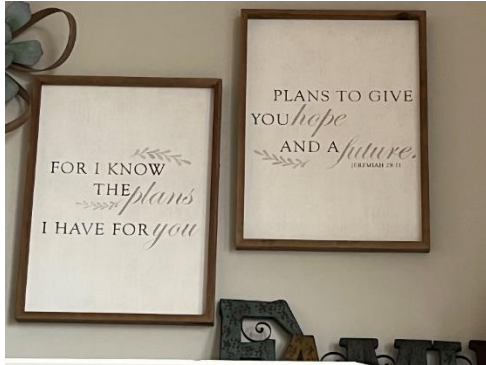
We hope you can join us as we fill our bodies and souls during this season of Lent.

On behalf of our President...

Recently I was blessed to spend a weekend visiting my cousin outside of Louisville, Kentucky. It was a great time and a much-needed retreat from the day-to-day. One thing to know about me, I tend to look for signs of God speaking to me through my surroundings, songs on the radio, or events and happenings in my day-to-day life. On my visit there, I had such an experience. Coming downstairs that Sunday morning for breakfast, I happened to look up at the wall above a built-in in their great room. There on the wall were two decorative frames, quoting Jeremiah 29:11 – “For I know the plans I have for you, plans to give you hope, and a future.” That message, at that moment, really struck me in my personal life circumstances, nearly bringing me to tears. I needed that clear message from the Lord right then. As I’ve pondered it since, I realize it is also a message for all of us, particularly in light of all we’ve been facing as a church family.



God may not often reveal his plans for us ahead of time, but He still wants us to know that Immanuel’s future, through His eyes, is full of hope. Hope in Pastor Rich’s continued recovery. Hope for our financial situation. And most importantly, hope in the opportunity that the current situation offers us for our spiritual growth, both individually, and as a body of believers. One way in which we need to do that is by formally creating a Stewardship Committee. As I write this, we are still in need of someone in our family to step up and lead that effort.

But beyond just a committee, we need a commitment, by all of us, to take the next step in our faith journey together and grow beyond a dependence on Pastor Rich, Jenny, and others on staff, to drive the ministries and events of Immanuel. As Lent and Easter approach, the opportunity lies before us. We need to carry on with the things we’ve done in the past: Ash Wednesday

Here's a slight update for property. Kettle Moraine Heating will be upgrading our gas piping to our new boiler. It was determined that the gas pipe diameter was not large enough to support our boiler. This will be done at no cost to us. Kettle Moraine will also be installing a small circulating pump to a water line that supplies our radiator in the Narthex. This has not been scheduled as of yet but it will happen in the near future. Time and materials came to \$1,400.00. This money will be coming out of our building fund.

If your desire is to have a say in your Memorial Service and ease the burden on those you've left behind, then you may want to consider filling out a Planned Funeral Information Sheet that can be kept on file here at Immanuel Church. This is strictly a form that covers questions regarding your wishes upon your passing in regard to a Memorial Service; it is not a legal document, nor is it any type of prepaid funeral planning package.

If you would like a form you will find them located in a pouch on the bulletin board outside of Pastor Rich's office.

Filled out forms can be put in Jenny Landowski's mailbox #4, and any questions can be directed to her as well.

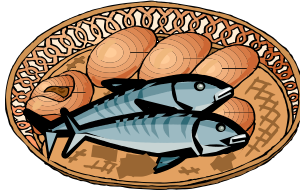

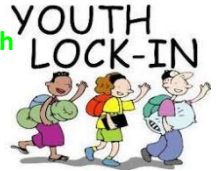

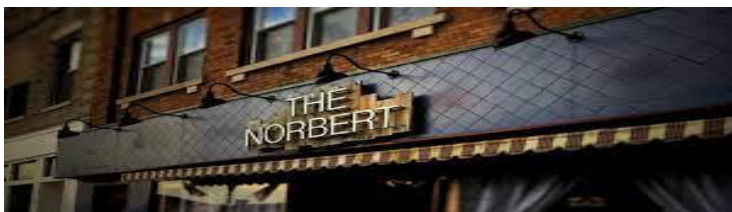

Period Poverty

Period Poverty is a term used to describe inadequate access to period products and the issues that go along with “that time of the month”. Often families are forced to make the hard decisions between putting food on the table or purchasing pads for their daughters; consequently, the absentee rate from school for these young girls is higher because they don’t have the proper protection to allow them to attend. Women who are trying to provide for themselves and their families also can fall into this category; they need feminine hygiene products so they can work, but often it’s in exchange for buying food.

The same scenario can also affect adults who suffer from incontinence; purchasing grown-up diapers is not cheap.

Food or personal hygiene protection...it shouldn’t have to be a choice.

Why are we bringing this to your attention? Because many of the people we serve at our Circle of Friends Shoppe possibly fall into this category. We need your help so we can help them!

form and return it with a check for \$30.00 to the church office. After the second service, the sponsoring member can take the flowers home.

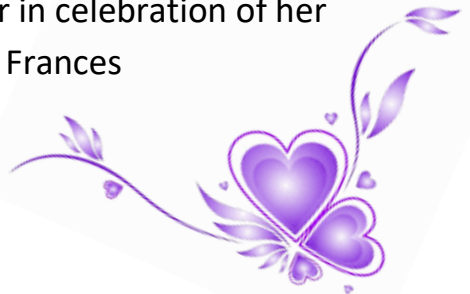
