Embrace the sacredness of Lent.

Thoughts from our Pastoral Assistant / Director of Ministries

As I'm sitting in my office writing this message, I'm currently in communication with Pastor Jim Schleif as to whether or not we should cancel our Ash Wednesday Service because of the projected forecast...weather in Wisconsin can be so unpredictable. It's a decision that is not taken lightly as we way out options and scenarios. This is just one of many decisions that needs to be made in the life of our church that impacts our community as a whole. Then, of course, there are our own personal decisions that we are faced with throughout each day, some simple, others not so easy. What will I eat today and is it a good choice for me, to what should I wear based on the weather or my mood. Recently. on the grander scale, I was faced with the decision as to whether I should stay in the home that Big Bob and I raised our family in, or should I sell it...then what? Recognizing that I needed to break some of these decisions down to make them more manageable was my first realization. While deciding what to eat is something I have to ask myself multiple times a day, what to wear could certainly be redefined by limiting my choices...hence my decision to take on the "100 day Wool& dress challenge"; what a freeing feeling it has been thus far to have one less decision to make each day. For financial and emotional reasons, selling my house wasn't so much the big question as was what comes next...hence my decision to take up the generous offer extended by my daughter Emma and son-in-law Nick, to move in with them along with Johanna, Sophie and our two dogs; the tremendous sense of peace this move is currently offering is allowing me space to simply breathe. Within this short amount of time, as it's been not quite three weeks since I put on the dress and took refuge in my child's home, I can already feel the fog starting to break up, and the light I am called to follow getting a bit brighter. Within these baby steps, I am also acknowledging the need to be more intentional about my quiet time with our Lord, something that, within the current craziness of my life, has not always been given appropriate priority.

All this being said, I am realizing the greater value and sacredness of Lenten disciplines such as removing things within our life that are a distraction so we can not necessarily replace them with something else, but maybe just allow ourselves time to be still. Certainly, taking on something else should be considered only after asking yourself if something needs to be eliminated first. I truly think that too many times we fall short of achieving what we've set out to do simply because we've rushed in to it without giving ourselves permission to clear our hearts and minds first.

Although, Lent has already started, my prayer for each of you, and for myself, is to find time for "sacred pause". As we wait in hope for the return of Pastor Rich, as we face the decisions of each day, and as we walk through life and all it holds, may God find us in the silence and speak to each of us the words we need to hear.

Property Update...

Since the last Journey Connection Kettle Moraine Heating upgraded our gas line diameter to our new boiler. On February 3rd we did have an issue with the boiler not igniting. A call was made to KMH and they sent out their boiler tech to trouble shoot our problem. After several phone calls to an engineer and an actual NTI Boiler tech the service technician was instructed on what adjustments needed to be made to keep out new boiler to run efficiently. Since that time we have not had any issues with the new boiler.

The circulating pump was installed in the water line that feeds the radiator in the Narthex. This will improve the movement of the heated water. Prior to this because of the long run when the water reached the radiator it was already cooled down and was not performing as it should.

A new flat panel TV was installed in the Adult Ed Room. The other TV decided it was tired and didn't want to work anymore. A big thanks to an anonymous church member that donated the funds to replace the TV. Thank you.

One other issue which we failed to mention in last month's Property report was that during our issue on Christmas Eve with our boiler, we also had a frozen fire sprinkler line which in turn caused a sprinkler head to freeze up. A call was made to Ahern Fire Protection on Christmas Eve and we were instructed on how to shut down the system. Fortunately we did not have any water damage. Ahern was able to get to us and replace the broken sprinkler head the next week and reactivate our sprinkler system.
