Thoughts from our Pastoral Assistant / Director of Ministries

This season of Lent has been especially meaningful for me, and I am grateful to have walked through it with so many of you. Some of our Wednesday Night Devotions touched on the feeling of being empty, as well as the need to empty ourselves of various things from emotions to "stuff". We wrestled with bringing the things we hide in the darkness into the light so that real healing and wholeness can begin. Then, how do we learn to trust God through this all. The SonShine Gals discussed "Communing" with God and with each other, being faithful stewards of our bounty, and walking with grace, especially when we're interrupted. During staff meetings, we talked about the need to live and lead out of hope of coulds instead of the shame of shoulds. Consistory, reflected on the importance of waiting...on God's timing, and how choice of actions become habits, habits easily become character, character inevitably becomes destiny; each step an arrival at who we are becoming. And, I haven't even touched on the Sunday morning messages that gave us food for thought about rocks, living in the light, and dry bones!

Sitting here watching it snow like crazy, it's hard to believe the calendar has officially turned to Spring. 
