## A WORD, OR TWO FROM OUR PASTOR...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

Wow! This is my first pastor's letter in months. It's been a long while since I've offered some words in our Journey Connection. In some ways, it feels like just a moment. In other ways, it feels like a lifetime ago.

When I think about all the ways the last few months could have gone, I am overwhelmed by gratitude. Certainly, this was the hardest physical gauntlet I've ever endured. There were weeks and weeks where swallowing was painful, eating was difficult, and moving was exhausting. Simply changing position in bed was agonizing. And because I prefer to suffer alone (and quite frankly had little energy to do otherwise), I was alone (by choice) for weeks on end.

But I knew something that kept my spirits up in the darkest hours. I knew that there was a boatload of people praying for me. I knew that so many were patiently supporting me. And so, in the darkest hours, I had reason to fight and push through. I could fight because you stood with me. I could fight because "my people" — my family, my church, my friends — were with me in spirit and hoping for the best. I can't overestimate how much every act of support and kindness meant to me. By the grace of God, I am alive because of it. And by the grace of God, I hope to make the best of this new lease on life.

So, as I stumble forward in this new stage of life, I do it with renewed confidence and great gratitude. I have been given more years and I hope to use them to joyfully grow in grace and love. My immune system is still low. My sense of taste is still off. My energy is still replenishing. Every two weeks or so I will go in for bloodwork and evaluation. In a few weeks, I can take my first vaccine. By December (a year from the transplant), I should have all my vaccines and life will be as close to normal as I can get.

I am rambling. I guess my point is this: Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! You have been a lifeline to me. Your love, care, and support sustained me through my darkest hour. I am eternally grateful, and I give thanks to God, and I give thanks for you!

### **Property update**

Due to the construction on main street, our church parking lot will be home to Music on Main this summer, on Thursday evenings, starting June  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ . The Downtown West Bend Association will be sponsoring the event. The association will make a donation each time they utilize our property between June 1st thru August  $\mathbf{17}^{\text{th}}$ .

Preparation has already started. A storage container was delivered and placed on the south end of our lot. Electrical work was completed so that Music on Main will have the power they need. They will be drawing power from our church, but it will be metered, and we will be reimbursed for any electricity they use.



All expenses will be funded by the Downtown Association. We will keep updating as more info becomes available.

On another note, TDS, a fiber optic company approached us to ask for permission to install a pedestal on our property between our church and the Circle of Friends house. This pedestal will contain fiber network cable etc. They have agreed to pay us \$10,000.00 plus landscaping fees to complete this project.

Our leadership approved that request and we have received those funds from the TDS company.


