Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

And as your pace of life shifts, my hope is that you'll continue to commit to regular worship. Your faithful presence is certainly needed in order for us to bear faithful witness as a community of faith and to grow together in grace, love, and unity.

But I remain hopeful that this will be worked out and I can tell you that I'm absolutely grateful to be alive and have the opportunity to serve and be with you!

I think that's all for now. My wish is that you would have a wonderful, relaxing, fulfilling summer and that our weekly gatherings would both increase and intensify your joy in Christ and your passion for life.

On behalf of our President...

Every year in May, after our Spring Congregational Meeting, the Consistory elect officers for the coming year. After prayerful consideration, I made the decision to not only step aside as President, but also step away from Consistory altogether. While it wasn't an easy decision, it had become clear that I needed to simplify my life. Laying down the burden of leadership at Immanuel was the clearest path to do that while remaining confident that things would be in more than capable hands. As I considered all the wonderful people I'm leaving behind, I realized that only two, save Pastor Rich and Jenny, were a part of Consistory when I rejoined back in 2020. I find that very encouraging. It shows that our church is dynamic, and that we have a strong group of members willing to step up and step in to serve in ways they haven't before.

To be certain, those folks, and all of us at Immanuel, continue to be challenged with the current financial situation of the church. Throughout my tenure as President, I have sought to be a voice of faith in the midst of our challenges. With this final note, I hope to continue that. As believers in Christ, we should always expect trials. After all we are people of faith, not facts. We are a community of believers, not knowers. The one thing we do know is that God is sovereign. He has always been faithful to see Immanuel through whatever challenges have come our way. What we must do is continue to pray, to believe, to give of all that we have as best we can, and to trust Him to see us through this current situation.

What we must not do is panic. When facing financial issues, the practical, human reaction is to jump to action, to tighten our belts, to see whether what we're spending those precious dollars on is really necessary. As someone who's been in church leadership for many years here, I've seen many budget proposals, and been in many sometimes-heated debates over the numbers on those pages. Let me tell you, every line item in our church's budget IS ministry. Every dollar IS mission. Every budget proposed by Finance Committee, reviewed by Consistory, and approved by our congregation, must be a statement of faith. As hard as it can be for us to say "yes" to a number we have no earthly certainty we can cover, to approach it any differently is to deny the very core of why we belong to this church, and why we profess Jesus Christ as our Lord. We must continue to believe that just as He has before, through every prior budget deficit, every flooded basement, every cancer-stricken pastor, He will again provide for us.

In Joshua 1:9, God tells Joshua "Have not I commanded you? Be strong, and of good courage. Be not afraid, neither be dismayed. For the Lord your God is with you, whithersoever you go." We as a family of believers need to take hold of those words and anchor ourselves to them. Immanuel means "God with us." As always, we must go forward believing He is,

and He always will be.


Financial Secretary...

Please prayerfully consider...

As the COVID pandemic has eased its grip, and restrictions have eased as well, it is now time to consider the next move with respect to travel and India. 2023-24 would traditionally be the next India Task Force-lead trip to Madhavapatnam to visit the Valluri Family and Marshall Public School. However, your Task Force has decided that it would be of great benefit to bring the Valluri family here to West Bend instead.

The last time the Valluri's were here was in 2018. Since that time Immanuel Church has been blessed with many new members who have never met them and heard the story of our mission in India firsthand. Yet they are supporters and trust what we are doing there. We would like them to have the opportunity to become acquainted with the Valluris in person and experience their enthusiasm and joy in serving in this ministry. The Immanuel community will benefit by hearing firsthand the impact that our prayerful and financial support has on this shared ministry in India.

Since Manjula, Novahu, Karishma and Shekinah were here the last time, a new member has been added to the family. In February Karishma married a young man, Praveen Bommu. Along with the girls he will one day be transitioning into a leadership role within the Joyful Journeys ministry. They are excited for us to meet him, as are we. We look to them to continue the work that has been established between Immanuel Church and Marshall School. It is good to have the assurance of the continuity of the relationships we have with each other.

The India Task Force is certainly aware of the cost of bringing the family here but feels that the benefits of their presence with us is needed to strengthen our relationship with the family and Marshall Public School. We estimate the cost of bringing them to West Bend to be \$2000 per person. Total \$10,000. We are asking that you prayerfully consider financially supporting this endeavor. We are looking to have them in our midst this fall of 2023. The Task Force is available if you have any questions or concerns. We are praying for God's mercy and grace as we look to our future with the staff and children in our school in India.
