A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

I'm writing this as the first snow of the year is descending upon us and it reminds me of the challenges and struggles of this time last year.

This time last year I was receiving a seemingly endless barrage of chemo treatments combined with blood transfusions in order to treat my bone cancer. It was about this time last year that my energy finally sputtered out and I had to give up ministering. It was also about this time last year that I got leukemia. The goal had been to have the transplant before I got leukemia, but in spite of all the careful planning and continuous monitoring, I came down with it anyway.

The bleakness of the snow reminds me of where my mind was at during this time. I had no guarantee that my life as I knew it would continue. The transplant procedure had an element of risk and even if successful, I was told that I'd never feel worse (and the doctors were right).

Having hit bottom, I rejoice today in the fact that I continue to grow daily in strength and stamina. I had no guarantee of more life and faced a risky possibility that my future would be dire. And now, nearly 10 months after the procedure, I look back over some very hard times, but also give thanks for many wonderful moments that I've been allowed to experience because life continues for me.

My goal in life is to increasingly grow in faith, hope, and love, learning every day what it means to follow Christ. That goal continues today because of the faithful work of health care professionals, the faithful prayers of God's people, and the faithful love of so many friends and family who have shown support and care throughout these past months.

I want you all to know how deeply grateful I am for you and your presence in my life. Without you my life would be less full. As we approach the season of Thanksgiving and the celebration of the Advent of our Lord, I am grateful to be able to be present and participate in your lives. Indeed, at this point, "thanks" hardly communicates my gratitude, but it's the best word I can find to express my heart.

May God be present for you during the coming bleak winter months, and may our presence together provoke us to faith, hope, love, and good works that build up others and shine the light of God's love into the world.



- Renovations to the apartment rental space at Cedar Valley (completed)
