A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

Now that Advent and Christmas are past us, we move into one of my favorite seasons of the Church Calendar – the Season of Epiphany.

Epiphany is a time of new revelation. It involves reflecting anew on who Christ is for us and for the world. It allows us to focus our attention on the central figure of our faith who is both our Savior and Lord.

I think the thing I love so much about Epiphany is that it allows us to confess that our understanding of Jesus can always use some refurbishing and refreshing. Over the years, our sense of Christ can become overly domesticated and comforting. Don't get me wrong – Jesus is our friend. He brings us peace. He is for us and not against us. However, all these beautiful truths do not remove the "edges" from Jesus' character and the "high calling" he invites us to.

Think about it. If we don't constantly reconsider who Jesus is, we easily descend into thinking we have him figured out, thinking that he is just like us. We assume he shares our morality, our politics, our personality, even our likes and dislikes. But Jesus is always greater than we can imagine. He cannot be boxed in – even by our religious imagination.

So, this year, my prayer for you (and for myself) is that we would be surprised by Jesus once again. That we might hear anew with fresh faith about his remarkable life and teaching and find ourselves overcome once again with joy, delight, and wonder — and yes, perhaps with a new awareness that Jesus breaks our comfortable stereotypes and simplistic formulations. That the Jesus we worship and follow is all that we desire and yet greater than we can imagine, and thus free to challenge us anew to deeper movements of faith, hope, and love.

It is my great joy to move into this new year by beginning once again to attempt to see – as best as we can – who Jesus is and what that means for us and the world. May this Epiphany shed new light to us and create new life in us!

In case you did not already know, both Immanuel United Church of Christ and Joyful Journeys, Inc. have the capability to receive online donations. You can set-up payment via ACH from your checking account or use a credit/debit card. Just so you know that if you choose to use a credit/debit card there is a small fee of about 3.1% which the service provider reduces the amount we receive by. For example, if you give \$100.00 using ACH from your checking account, we receive \$100.00 vs if you use a debit or credit card, we receive \$96.90, therefore the fee for \$3.10 is absorbed by either Immanuel or Joyful Journeys.
