# A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

There's a saying that speaks of "the inexorable march of time", or as I've also heard it, "time marches inexorably on." "Inexorable" means "impossible to stop or prevent." In other words, "time marches on" and we are powerless to do anything about it other than interpret our perception of what the passing of time means for us.

For me, sometimes time is excruciatingly slow. During my long weeks of illness during Epiphany of this year, my experience of time ground to a halt. But, for the most part, I usually experience the sense that "time flies!" It seems like the moment one week is completed that it is immediately followed by the race to prepare for another week, only to have that arrive sooner than expected, followed by another, and another, and so on and so on. (You get the point!)

For example, it seems like only moments ago that we were celebrating Advent, and praying during Lent, and rejoicing during Easter. Thinking further back, it has now been a year since I returned to the pulpit (May of last year), and though in some ways that feels like an eternity ago (because of how difficult it was at first), it also feels like it has flown by. The experience of time is such a strange and wondrous mystery.

No matter: "Time marches inexorably on." Our school year is almost up. Easter season is nearly over and Pentecost, Ascension, and Trinity Sunday are around the corner. Then comes the long season of Ordinary Time.

So, whether your experience of time is that of still waters or a rushing stream, my hope is that you will make time to participate in our regular weekly gatherings to celebrate and witness to our shared faith and commitment to our shared mission. Time marches on, but it is a great joy and consolation to share moments together with you and yours.

The school year is almost done, and so is Spring Shine! Just one more day, and it's gonna be a good one- it's the End of Year Party!


