The West Bend Fire Department did their annual inspection and only found one minor issue. We had some of our emergency exit lights where the battery backup was not functioning as it should. New batteries were placed on order and when they are received, they will be installed on the lights that failed the inspection.

They also mentioned that we had some ceiling tiles that were missing in the downstairs maintenance room.


It's time to replace the roof over the south half of our church building. Praise the Lord, this roof has served us well for the past 40+ years!



Throughout India, there are countless children who are deemed "semi-orphans"; these are kids from an unstable homelife, lacking a parent/s or living with a guardian. Recognizing many of these struggling children in the village, and wanting to provide for them, the first Joyful Journeys Hostel was established with space for 6 kids. After numerous additions, it currently houses 40 children.

Ramesh, a "semi-orphan", was 5 years old when he came to live at the hostel. He attended Marshall School, graduated with honors, went on to college and received his Bachelors Degree in Engineering. Ramesh now serves as a Board Member for Joyful Journeys in India. He is one of the 550 kids who have called the Joyful Journey Hostel "home" through the years. Oh, the power of LOVE!!

\$60 a month provides clothing, meals, basic essentials, schooling and the blessing of living in a family environment.




