A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ

The last few weeks have been challenging for me physically. For two of the last three weeks I've struggled with sickness, dry throat, and general fatigue. This fatigue has left me bedridden for days at a time. Feeling that this may be more than general sickness, I contacted my doctor at Grace clinic.

Yesterday (I'm writing this on July 31), my doctor performed some fresh bloodwork and we've discovered some concerning numbers related to my liver. And today, I'm scheduled for an Ultrasound of my liver to consider what treatment should be pursued.

The good news is that I start a 2-week vacation on August 4, 2025. My hope is that this will allow me ample opportunity to rest, recuperate, and get a better handle on what's going on in my body. Chaplain Esteve Roledad from Cedar Community will provide pulpit supply on August 10th and Reverend Jakob Kröner from Peace UCC in Kewaskum will do the same on August 17th.

Lord willing, I will be here this Sunday, August 3, to conclude our look at Genesis 1-3 (as we consider the unintended consequences of one moral failing) and to share in Communion with you.

Property update...

Otis Elevator was here to do their annual maintenance; no issues were noted.

Kettle Moraine Heating and A/C completed the portion of our Peace of Mind package that was servicing all of our condensers (A/C units) and there were no issues noted. Our furnaces and boilers will be serviced later this year, that will complete the agreement with KMH for this calendar year.

Our property team was able to get rid of a lot of junk furniture that was cluttering up our stage in the fellowship hall, along with some junk items that were in our storage garage.

Our snow removal company sold their business due to retirement, so we did receive a quote from the company that took over Scott's Landscaping, the company is Brant's Lawn Care. We also did contact Extra Mile Snow Removal, and they are sending us a quote also.

We met with Quinton Bendickxon from Arch Electric due to a request from the consistory to look into Solar Panels for future consideration to help offset energy costs. Quinton will be providing us with some options along with possible financial grants to help offset the future installation of these solar panels.

WHITECHAPEL HANDBELLS IMMANUEL CHURCH

The Whitechapel Foundry was established in 1570, and since then, thousands of bells have been sent to almost every country in the world. In addition to casting English Handbells, the foundry is also famous for its tower bells. Here is a very abbreviated list of some you may recognize:

Great Tom of St. Paul's Cathedral, London 1716
Christ Church, Philadelphia PA 1744
Liberty Bell, Philadelphia 1752
St. Michael's Church, Charleston SC 1764
Big Ben of Westminster in London 1853
Westminster Abbey 1919
Washington Cathedral, Washington DC 1963. Ring of 10 peal bells

A bell is tuned to five partial tones, spanning two octaves. The "strike" note, which is heard on the impact of the clapper and the "hum" note, which swells up afterwards, are the two most evident to our ears. The other tones are the minor third, the fifth and the octave above the strike note. The hum note should be one octave below the strike note. As well as being in tune with itself, each bell must be in tune with the others in the "ring", or set, so that the ring functions as a single musical instrument. The bell is cast as near as possible to the required note and the final tuning is done be removing metal from inside, by a large vertical lathe. When tuning handbells, the margin of error is so small that even the polishing needed to give the bells their beautiful finish must also be allowed for.

Immanuel's handbells are a ring (or set) of 49 bells: they are four full octaves. The largest bell is low C, two octaves below middle C. It weighs just over 10 pounds and is over 11 inches in diameter. The smallest bell is high C, 2 octaves above middle C, weighs approximately 7 ounces and is about 2 inches in diameter. The bells are made of brass and have no protective finish. Care must be taken in handling them, and they are thoroughly polished and inspected each year by members of Immanuel's Handbell Ensemble.

In May of 1970, Immanuel Church placed its first order for handbells with the Whitechapel Foundry. This order was for 25 handbells, two octaves: "middle C" (C4) to "high C" (C6). The cost for the bells at that time was \$596.00. The current price of this two octave set today is \$17,235.00! This order of bells was not received at Immanuel Church until February of 1972. The Whitechapel Foundry had expected to fulfill the order within 12 months, but a 1971 dockers strike in the United States closed all shipping delaying the order almost a full year.

In March of 1973, Immanuel Church requested the expansion the existing set with the addition of 6 larger, lower bells. Price for these bells was \$206, with expected delivery in 10 months. Due to the generosity of its congregation, Immanuel Church was able to request that 3 more bells to be added to this order further expanding the set. However, Whitechapel Foundry advised that the addition of these bells would delay the shipment an additional 8 months, and Immanuel Church decided to forgo these additional bells and return to the original order of 6 bells. Whitechapel Foundry experienced severe delays in fulfilling this order and by July of 1975 informed Immanuel Church of the anticipated fulfillment date of the following September of 1975. At this point, Immanuel Church changed the order from 6 bells to 20 bells, bringing the set to "low C" (C3) to "high G#" (G#6). These bells were received in October of 1975.

A final order was placed in August 1997 for 4 more bells to complete the set to what it is now: 4 full octaves ranging from "low C" (C3) to "high C" (C7).

It is a pleasure to ring Immanuel's Whitechapel Handbells, and it is our prayer that they continue to bless the worship of Immanuel's congregation for years to come.



Our fabulous, feathered friends,


