Thoughts from our Pastoral Assistant / Director of Ministries

Dear Immanuel Church family and friends,

Last month, I wrote an article reflecting on Ecclesiastes 3 stating that we were entering a new season here at Immanuel...a time of regathering after a summer of being scattered as well as a time of weeping as I shared the news of Pastor Rich's returned cancer. Here we are, a month later, what season do we find ourselves in now? What time are we in as individuals and as a body of Christ?

The author of Ecclesiastes says there is a time for everything... Our musicians have a time to make music as they strum, drum, ring, and sing. Our youth have a time to laugh as they find joy in being a part of J.A.M. Time, CORE, and SHINE. Our adults have a time to speak as they participate in SonShine Gals, Wise Guys, and Sharing Today's Word. Our India Ministry will have a time to dance as we celebrate its 20th Anniversary at our upcoming Gala. Even our church building is finding a time to break down as it prepares for a new roof.

But what happens between the *specific times* for every matter under heaven? King Solomon didn't mention anything about a time to wait! So, for now, I guess we'll shift from King Solomon to Dr. Suess as we find ourselves in "The Waiting Place" ...

As I write this, it has been 2 months since Pastor Rich first went into the hospital with health concerns. Then we waited for a diagnosis...only to find out his cancer has returned. It's been about 8 weeks since he began his aggressive chemo treatments. Then we waited to see if it had successfully attacked the cancer. It's been about 6 weeks since he began needing regular blood and platelet transfusions. Then we waited to see if they brought strength to his incredibly weakened body. It was about 4 weeks ago that we all read Pastor Rich's heartfelt letter of renewed hope and determination to move forward, once his body was strong enough, with another series of intense chemo treatments. Then we waited, also with hope, for him to begin round two of the fight. It was 20 days ago that Pastor Rich went back into the hospital because of complications... We are still waiting for answers and for him to come home.

Now, although Dr. Suess at least acknowledges "The Waiting Place", he doesn't offer the best advice as to what we should do while we're in it. So now, we'll shift to King Solomon's dad, King David to see what he suggests. In Psalm 27 verse 14 it states, "Wait for the LORD; Be strong and let your heart take courage; Yes, wait for the LORD."

What does it mean to "wait for the LORD"? It means *actively* trusting and hoping in God's promise, timing and strength to give us what we need to face the trials in front of us. "*Actively Trust and Hope*"! It means continue to engage in a meaningful life and maintain a close relationship with God, even when things are difficult...as you wait.

I invite you to join me in King David's "Waiting Place", it's called Immanuel ~ God with us, where together we will draw courage from each other, and strength from our collective worship, as we wait...

Your continued prayers and heartfelt messages for Pastor Rich are immensely appreciated by him...as he waits.





- In addition to hygiene packs that have been assembled by Onward, there is regularly bags of clothes that needs to be driven to Grafton and dropped off at Mr. Bob's Under the Bridge. Jim, Judy, and Ed often fill their vehicles and make the trip over. We give thanks for their dedication to both outreach programs!!

- Sandy and Elaine spend numerous hours a week restocking after the Shoppe has been open to ensure it's ready for the next wave of customers to come through. Where do they restock from?? The whole second floor of the house is filled with our overflow and seasonal items. We give thanks for their enthusiasm and thoroughness in keeping The COF Shoppe organized!!
- Our awesome team of volunteers make sure the COF Shoppe can be open 5 times a month. Their compassionate hearts guide them to serve all who come through with dignity and respect. We give thanks for their commitment and kindness!!


