Property update...

This past month was busy to say the least. First of all, our roof and gutters were replaced on the new portion of our building. Thanks to our congregation members and others that donated monies to this effort, the support we receive from you all is truly amazing.

Our elevator had a small issue when we lost power to the elevator. The main breaker had tripped but we were able to reset it. The elevator technician thinks that we possibly had a power surge that caused that breaker to trip. The breaker could be weak being that it was installed in 1990. We might have to replace the breaker in the future if this continues to be a problem.

The water heater that handles the hot water for our kitchen, men's and lady's bathroom and classrooms downstairs failed. The water heater was over 10 years old. We were able to pick up a replacement, and we got it installed. Everything is up and running again.

Air Conditioners were removed from the Circle of Friends windows and stored for the winter. The boiler was turned on for the winter season.


